Health & Safety Policy for Field Trials

General Policy To provide adequate awareness of the health and safety risks involved in our activities.

Those attending a field trial should be aware of the nature of the activity and informed about any potential hazards.

Responsibilities Overall responsibility for health and safety is that of the Field Trial Committee and Officers of The Yellow Labrador Club. All those involved with the trial should be responsible for taking care of the health and safety of themselves and others, and to follow instructions with regard to procedures and safety.

Pre-Field Trial Briefing The Chief Steward will be responsible for safety, supervision and discipline at the Field Trial, and will outline the risks involved before the commencement of the trial. **ONCE THE TRIAL HAS STARTED NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE WITHOUT FIRST NOTIFYING THE CHIEF STEWARD.** It is expected that everyone present will comply with the highest standards of safety and sportsmanship – with respect to quarry, wildlife and the countryside in general.

The Red Flag This indicates the safe location of spectators and competitors not in the line; and Guns should be aware of the location of the flag.

Dogs Handlers are responsible for the control of their dogs and ensuring they do not cause injury or accidents.

Topography The ground used for our Trials is varied and challenging. Heather moorland, ditches, fences, and streams may have to be negotiated. The ground is often rugged and at times walking may be difficult. It is recommended that suitable footwear is worn and appropriate clothing according to the shooting custom. Field Trials take place in all kinds of weather and participants should be dressed appropriately for the conditions. Also a **REASONABLE LEVEL OF FITNESS IS REQUIRED.** The Yellow Labrador Club cannot accept responsibility for injury, loss or damage to person or property however occasioned

Rules & Regulations for Field Trials

1. Members will receive preference in draws; but members joining after 30th June will not receive preference for the coming season's trials.
2. The order of the draw will be the order of running
3. The substitution of dogs similarly qualified by the draw date will be allowed up to three days prior to the Trial – the details of which must be included on the original entry form
4. Owners unable to accept a run, even on the reserve list **MUST** notify the FT Secretary as soon as possible. Owners failing to do so may, at the discretion of The Club, forfeit their entry fee.
5. All dogs must be registered at The Kennel Club in the name of the Owner.
6. Should circumstances so dictate The Club may, in consultation with the Judges, alter arrangements as necessary.
7. Owners competing in one trial whilst retaining a second overlapping run in another may have future entries rejected by The Club.
8. All trophies are to be engraved at the Winner's expense, held until required and returned in good condition for the following season's stake.
9. Preference in **Open Stakes:**
First, Second, Third or Fourth in a 2-day Open stake; or First, Second or Third in a 1-day Open stake; or First in an All-Aged or Novice Stake.
Preference in **Novice Stakes:** Dogs NOT having gained the above awards.
10. The Club may reserve the right to refuse any entry, except that this shall not apply in terms of the preference in the draw (Regulations J6.g). The Kennel Club must be notified in writing of all such refusals with the Club's reason.
11. No modification may be made to the schedule except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if the time permits before the closing of entries.
12. The Club expects all those attending Trials to wear clothes in keeping with a shoot day.
